The Associate of Fine Arts (AFA) degree offers a solid foundation in technical and performance areas of theatre that enables students to transfer to a four-year program and be successful!. Faculty work closely with colleges, universities and professional schools to ensure students are well prepared for upper division courses when they graduate with an AFA.

The program offers many opportunities for students to gain valuable hands-on experience. Each year there are five productions, including three full-length plays, a children's show and student directed one-act plays.

Community College Review recognized the program as one of the top theatre programs in the country in a September 2016 article titled, "Performing Arts at Community Colleges: Best Music and Theater Programs." For many years SFCC's students and faculty have participated in and received recognition at the annual Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival.

Advantages of SFCC Theatre

The **Stauffacher Theatre** underwent a \$500,000 renovation in 2017 that included a new sound system. It is a proscenium arch theatre with 24 fly lines, computerized lighting, fully-equipped scene shop, large modern dressing rooms, and a makeup area and costume shop. It seats 239 for an exceptional audience experience.

The **Thompson O'Sullivan Studio Theatre** focuses on intimate performances and allows for stage and seating configurations to change into venues such as theatre in the round, corner seating or arena seating for 80 to 90. The studio theatre is used for a main stage production; the annual Student Theatre Showcase; rehearsals; theatre classes; and other college and community events.

We have augmented agreements with Central Methodist University (CMU) that provide bachelor's degree programs at SFCC's Sedalia, Clinton, Lake of the Ozarks, and online campuses; University of Central Missouri (UCM) and University of Missouri-Columbia for specific on-ground programs; and Drury University, Grantham University and University of Phoenix for specific online programs. CMU and UCM also offer dual admission through SFCC.
