Program is fully approved by the Missouri State Board of Nursing (MSBN). Completion of programs does not guarantee eligibility to take licensure exams.

Admission to SFCC Nursing Program

- 2. Following acceptance to SFCC & Enrollment Checklist completion, meet with the pre-nursing navigator to discuss your educational plan.
- Complete the requirements for nursing program admission found at www.sfccmo.edu/nursing.
- 4. When ready, complete the online nursing program application.

Admission to the Nursing Program is on a first-qualified, first-admitted basis, pending satisfactory background and drug screening as well as completion of all required immunizations.
