BEFORE CLASS STARTS

Required Action	Fee	Additional Information
CDL driver's permit with air brake endorsement	\$41.00	You must obtain your CDL driving permit prior to starting the class. This is a written test. You can take the test and pick up study materials at your local driver's examination station. You must obtain the air brake endorsement at this time.
Complete and submit application		Submit application with copies of current CDL permit* and Driver's License - applications are dated and processed in order received. *Application is not considered complete without submission of CDL permit.
DOT physical and drug test	\$160	Non-refundable. Two weeks before the start of class you will be required to take a DOT physical and drug test. Payment is due at day of the test. SFCC will schedule your appointment. Results are sent directly to SFCC and will be available upon request.
Pay instructional fees	\$5,050	Due prior to the start of class. Refundable up to 21 days prior to class start date.

GETTING YOUR CREDENTIALS

Required Action	Fee	Additional Information
Take CDL certification test	Included	You will be provided with a tractor/trailer rig in which to take your test. Your test date will be scheduled as determined by the instructor.
Pay license fee (cost varies depending on the state in which you apply).	\$77 (MO)	After you pass the driving test, submit the required paperwork to obtain your license (this will be provided as part of the program). The \$77 fee is charged each time your license is changed, so you may want to consider obtaining additional endorsements at this time.

*ADDITIONAL ENDORSEMENTS

Endorsement	Fee	Additional Information
Hazardous Materials (HME)	\$86.50	CDL drivers, 21 or older, who wish to operate vehicles carrying hazardous materials that require placarding must have a HAZMAT endorsement on their CDL.
Tanker Endorsement	\$25	A tanker endorsement is only required if your vehicle needs a Class A or B CDL and you want to haul a liquid or liquid gas in a permanently mounted cargo tank rated at 119 gallons or more or a portable tank rated at 1,000 gallons or more.
Doubles/Triples Endorsement	\$25	Allows you to tow a double or triple trailer.
