# NEW RESIDENCE HALL CONSTRUCTION BID

Mr. Oldham moved the Board of Trustees accept the Base Bid from Professional Contractors & Engineers Incorporated (PCE) of Columbia, Missouri, in the amount of Thirteen Million, Six Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Dollars (\$13,676,000.00) for the construction of the State Fair Community College New Residence Hall. Six bid alternates and one voluntary addition from PCE are still being evaluated. The approval of all, or any of these, if selected, will be presented to the Board for approval in a subsequent meeting. Additionally, Mr. Oldham moved that the Board authorize the President and Vice President of Finance & Administration to execute the required contracts with PCE for the timely completion of the New Residence Hall. Mr. Parker seconded the motion; motion carried (Yes-5; No-0; Absent-1).

## SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

Mr. Oldham moved the Board of Trustees approve the sale of State Fair Community College personal property that has been determined to no longer be needed by the College and is thus deemed surplus property. These items will be sold at public auction in Sedalia, Missouri, and online on February 7, 2024. The auction is being conducted by Big Iron Auctions. Mr. Parker seconded the motion; motion carried (Yes-5; No-0; Absent-1).

In addition to unneeded classroom/office furnishings, kitchen equipment, electronics and computer equipment, the auction will include a Milbank 5 KW wind turbine generator, 4 MCI 52 – 56 passenger coach buses, a 2001 Chevrolet Malibu and a 2-bedroom, 2-bath manufactured home (Ozark Manufactured Homes) previously used by the SFCC Director of Student Housing.
