Bachelor of Applied Science in Logistics Operations (BASLO) University of Arkansas-Fort Smith In Partnership with State Fair Community College

State Fair Community College (SFCC) students may earn the Bachelor of Applied Science in Logistics Operations degree online from the University of Arkansas - Fort Smith. Students will complete the first two years (lower-level coursework) of the bachelor's degree requirements at SFCC by completing an Associate of Applied Science degree in a technical area. Completed SFCC courses will be accepted by UAFS and applied to the BASLO degree requirements according to the UAFS Undergraduate Academic Catalog. UAFS will offer the remaining BASLO requirements through online courses. Students will be able to transfer up to 75 credit hours of lower-level credits following this degree plan.

Student Degree Program Requirements

A student's degree program requirements are those specified in the catalog in effect at the time of declaration of program major. Students must meet the above program requirements and the graduation requirements as indicated by institutional and college policy. The program can be changed only with the approval of the official advisor. If original courses are eliminated, students may be required to meet new curriculum requirements in the degree program. If students are not enrolled for two or more consecutive terms (excluding summer terms), they must reenter under the program requirements of the current catalog. Students are responsible for understanding program requirements and changes. This document is not official until signed and dated by both the student and an authorized university representative.
