

# Unregistering TouchNet 360u from your phone

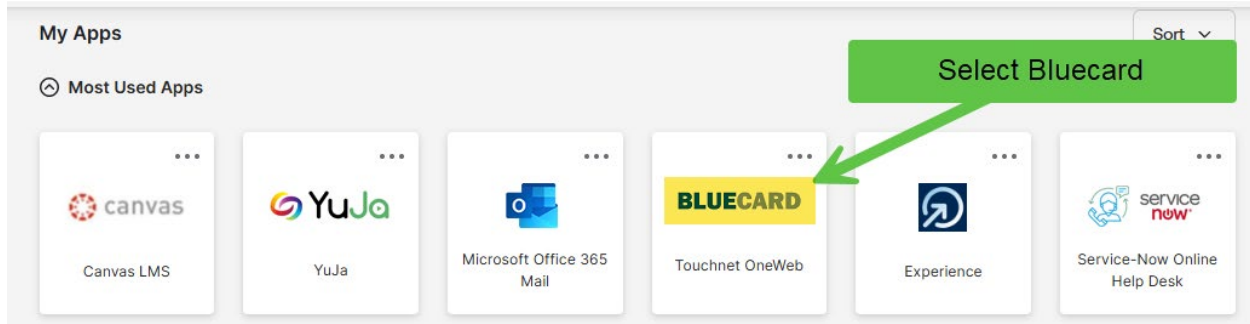
## Problem

Say you get a new phone, how do you get TouchNet306u on the new one. You need to start by unregistering the app which can easily be done in three steps by logging into Okta.

---

### Step 1: Open your Bluecard on your Okta Dashboard

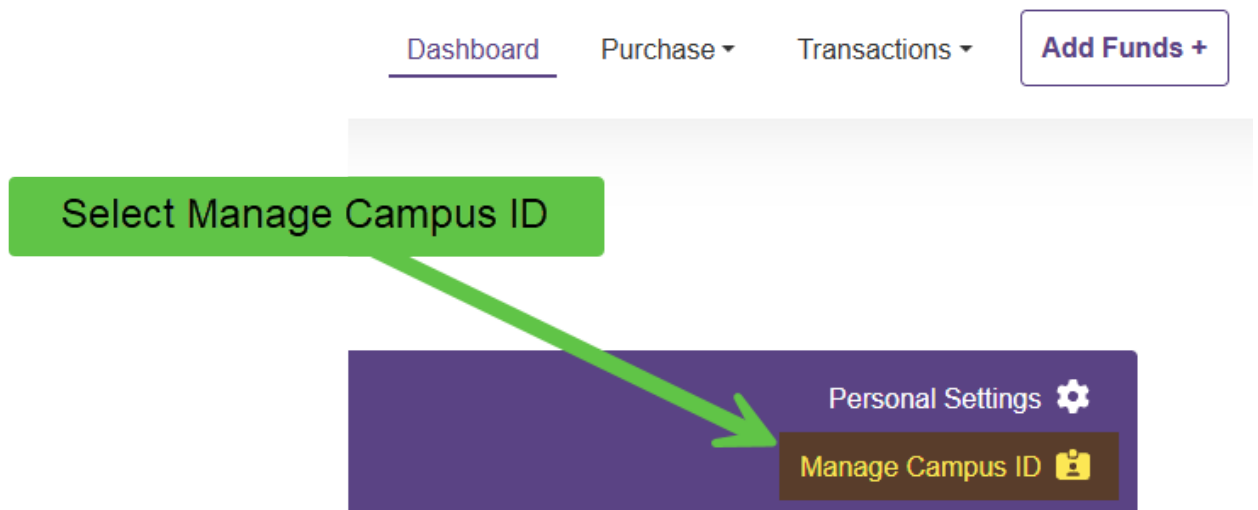
1. Go to Chrome or your favorite browser and to open your Okta Dashboard:

2. Select the Bluecard chiclet as shown below

### Step 2: First-Time Setup & Login

1. Under the Bluecard Dashboard, click on Manage Campus ID



### Step 3: Log Into SFCC

1. Select Unregister 360u App

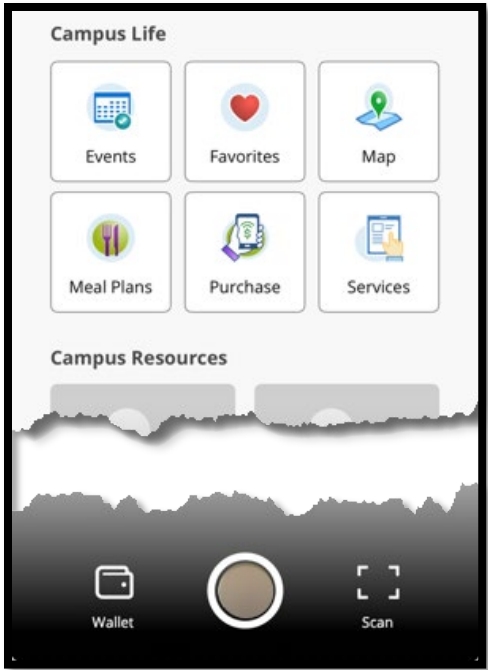

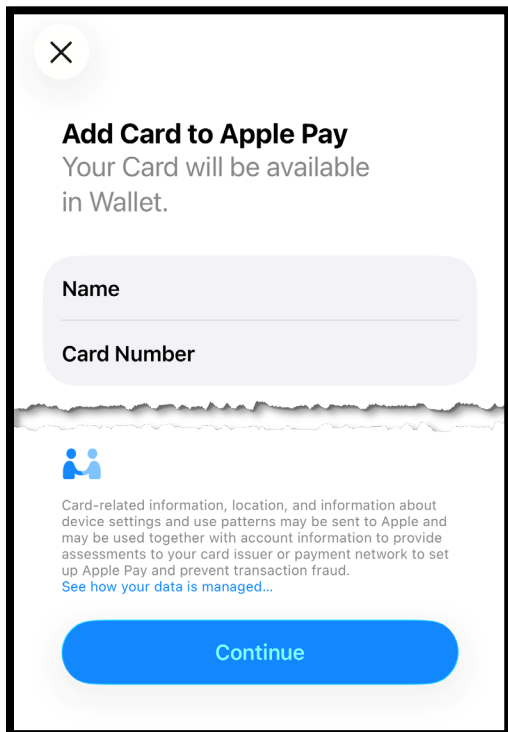
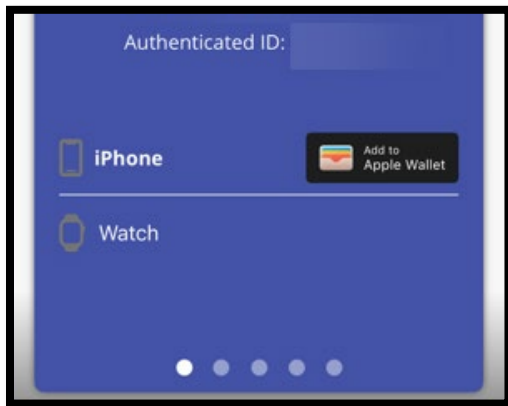


Once unregistered, Open the TouchNet 360u app on your phone, sign in.



## Step 6: Add Card to Wallet

1. After tapping your profile image at the bottom center, a new screen will appear with an option to add your ID card to Apple Wallet.
2. To add your card:
  - a. Tap **Add to Apple Wallet** on your iPhone.
  - b. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the setup.

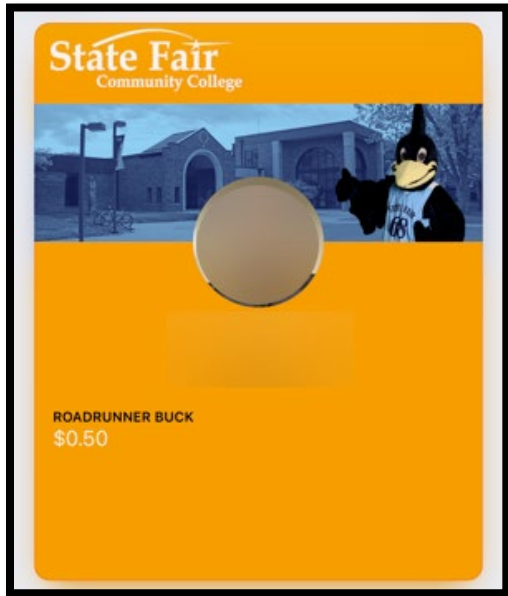


## Using Cards in Wallet
