Pell Grant

The amount of *Federal Pell Grant* funds you may receive over your lifetime is the equivalent of six years of Pell Grant funding or 600%. The maximum amount of Pell Grant funding you can receive each year is equal to 150%.

Since you are nearing your lifetime loan limit or Pell Grant, we wanted you to be aware of how much aid you have left to complete your degree. To remove the red flag on your mySFCC, submit the following items:

1. Complete the following at <https://studentaid.gov> Print Aid Summary for Loans and Grants. In the My Aid section of the Dashboard, click on View Details, click on View Breakdown, and then click on View Loan Details. Print the Loan Summary. Scroll back to the top, click on the Grants tab under Aid Summary and print the Grants Summary. Attach both the Loan Summary and the Grants Summary to the Aggregate Loan/Pell Limits form below.
