New Borrowers and first-time borrowers at SFCC:

- Complete Entrance Counseling
- Master Promissory Note (MPN)

Financial aid pays to student accounts based on current credit hours attending at the time of disbursement. Students must be attending at least 6 credit hours for student loans to pay. All federal student loans pay out in 2 disbursements within each semester. Late starting classes and less than full-time enrollment will impact timing and amounts of financial aid awards.
