## Why Criminal Justice?

A criminal justice degree offers a doorway to a variety of exciting and rewarding career opportunities in the private or government sectors. Specialty areas include law enforcement; probation and parole; juvenile justice; law; jail and prison corrections; agency administration; victim advocacy; emergency communications; and forensic investigations. Completion of the AAS requirements prepares students to enter a law enforcement training academy for Missouri police officers.

All SFCC criminal justice faculty are employed or previously employed in careers such as law enforcement, juvenile enforcement or probation/patrol, so instruction is relevant and infused with real-life experiences.
