Why Nursing?

Nursing career opportunities are abundant, from hospital and office practice to government, school nursing, nurse practitioners, and nurse attorneys—and the number of jobs is growing rapidly. Careers in nursing allow flexibility in employment settings and schedules.

SFCC's Nursing program is a competency-based bi-level program that prepares you to complete the requirements for the Professional Certificate in Practical Nursing (Year One) and the requirements for the Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (Year Two). It allows you to transition seamlessly from practical nursing to associate degree nursing. An advanced placement option is available for current licensed practical nurses into Year Two. The program is offered at several locations:

At SFCC, active learning takes place in fully multimedia classrooms equipped with SMART board™ technology and e-instruction. Our Human Patient Simulators™ allow you to develop and improve your critical decision-making skills in a real-life setting. The program prepares you to become a registered professional nurse in an educational environment that promotes critical thinking, personal growth and a holistic view of health care. SFCC also has an active Nursing Club that provides opportunities for socialization and campus and community service.

Admission is competitive and requires an additional admission application, as well as background and drug screenings. Application packets are available online at www.sfccmo.edu/nursing.

The Nursing program has full approval by the Missouri State Board of Nursing (MSBN). At the completion of Level One, students apply to the MSBN for the NCLEX-PN licensure exam for practical nursing. At the end of Level Two, students apply to the MSBN to take the NCLEX-RN licensure exam for registered nursing. Completion of these programs does not guarantee eligibility to take the licensure exams.
