

Multiple Measures for Placement into College-Level Courses

Have you recently graduated from high school or are you still in high school?

If **YES** to either of these questions, you may be eligible for the Multiple Measures for Placement into college-level courses. Go to the next question.

If **NO** to either of these questions, you may still be eligible. Go to the next question.

Is or was your cumulative, unweighted high school grade point average 3.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale?

If **YES**, you may be eligible; go to the next question.

If **NO**, you are not eligible.

Is or was your high school graduation date less than four years ago from your college application date?

If **YES**, you must provide SFCC with your official high school transcript to use Multiple Measures for Placement to enroll in college-level courses.

If **NO**, you are not eligible.

Have you asked your high school counselor to send your most current official high school transcript to SFCC?

If **YES** and your cumulative GPA is **3.5 or higher**, you are eligible to use the Multiple Measures for Placement to enroll in college-level courses.

If **NO**, you must provide SFCC with an **official high school transcript** if you want to use Multiple Measure Placement for course scheduling. Please make sure you meet all the other qualifications first.
