The Master of Science in Athletic Training (MSAT) program is an entry-level master's program that is designed to prepare students for the Board of Certification examination (BOC) and to prepare students for an entry-level career in the prevention, evaluation, treatment, and rehabilitation of athletic injuries.

The MSAT degree is a 60 credit-hour curriculum completed over 2 years (6 semesters, including summers) and is a combination of classroom learning and clinical work. This program is intended for college graduates who want a career in athletic training and have met the admissions requirement for the MSAT program.
