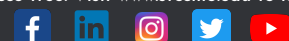

The Motorcycle Safety Foundation's (MSF) Basic Rider Course (BRC) offered by The LearningForce at State Fair Community College is designed for beginning or re-entry riders. Online pre-instruction prepares students for a minimum of eleven hours of practical riding maneuvers and skills on a designated range with certified instructors. Motorcycles are provided.

All participants are required to provide and wear the following proper protective clothing during all practice riding lessons:

- Full fingered gloves
- 3/4 or full helmet \*NO half shells
- Eye protection
- Long sleeve shirt/hoodie or jacket
- Long pants & boots that cover the ankle
- No rips/tears/holes on clothing.

Upon confirmation of payment, student will receive an email with instructions on how to complete the online eCourse using a code provided. **THE ONLINE COURSE MUST BE COMPLETED PRIOR TO THE FIRST RIDING SESSION.** You will need to print the completion certificate and bring it with you.

Successful completion of BRC course waives BOTH written AND rider skills test portions for the state license, and some insurance companies may offer a discount on rates.
